EBOLA IS ONLY THE BEGINNING IN LIBERIA.

In the midst of a deadly disease, and much fear, the spread of the virus is only one aspect of the suffering taking place right now in Liberia.

- **Food shortages have begun** as importers have ceased to deliver to West Africa for fear of transporting the disease.
- **Corruption is taking hold** as food and other vital supplies are stockpiled by a few to control supply and drive prices up.
- **Access to medical care is nearly nonexistent** for non-Ebola patients as providers focus on containing the virus.
- **Isolation is increasing for rural areas** as travel and transport of goods beyond Monrovia has become difficult if not impossible.

The World Health Organization has estimated that up to 20,000 may die from Ebola before the crisis is over.* This estimate does **not** include those who may die from lack of food or medical care.
